

Position Title: Machinist C

Department: Production

A. PURPOSE OF POSITION

Set up and operate various machine tools, following established methods and procedures, to machine a limited amount of parts to meet time and customer requirements.

B. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

In addition to functions performed by the Utility Person, perform the following:

1. Receive and interpret oral/written instructions from supervisor(s) and/or assigned personnel.
2. Set up and operate machine tools to perform basic machining operations on all types of apparatus.
3. Troubleshoot and debug problems and program CNC machine for straight, taper and radial turning on CNC machine tools.
4. Assist assigned personnel on all types of projects when required. Disassembly, inspection, repair, reassembly and installation of all types of motors, generators, pumps, valves, turbines, etc.
5. Maintain a neat and orderly work area.
6. Abide by all safety/environmental rules and regulations.
7. May be assigned to field to support service work as required. Must be nuclear ready.
8. Perform other functions as necessary.

C. CONTACTS

1. Daily contact with supervisor(s) and/or assigned personnel. Little contact with customers or outside vendors.

D. EQUIPMENT USED

1. Vertical boring mill, engine and turret lathe, shaper, slotter, CNC machine tools, vertical milling machines, etc. Other/personal hand tools as required.

E. EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Education: High school graduate or recognized equivalent
2. Specialized training: Must be enrolled in or a graduate of the Machinist Apprentice Training Program or recognized equivalent.

F. EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Must have at least two (2) years experience as a machinist apprentice or recognized equivalent. Must possess hand tools required to perform the position's essential functions.
2. Must have a valid driver's license and the appropriate state mandated minimum automobile insurance requirements.

G. DIRECTION RECEIVED

1. Procedures are established for normal work assignments. Interpret written/oral instructions given by supervisor(s) or assigned personnel, to carry out assigned duties, but seeks advice when needed. Instructions/guidance provided for new or non-standard assignments.

H. DIRECTION GIVEN

1. Provide instruction and guidance to lower graded and new employees as needed.
